Matthew McDougall was one of the most colourful and talented characters in the Sydney Scottish Country Dancing scene in the 1970s and 80s. Having just obtained his Teacher's Certificate at St Andrews Summer School, he collapsed and died at Heathrow Airport on his way home on 16th September 1983. Matthew showed his considerable artistic talent in producing, and costuming many Branch items for the Annual Winter Schools. His sixteen dancer set for his own dance "Really", was an outstanding contribution for which the whole Winter School at Geelong stood in acclamation for its brilliance.
